Meeting Summary

This Curriculum Advisory Council meeting was called for an informational meeting about the calculus College in the High School (CiHS) course material. The calculus CiHS course at Pullman High School offers students the opportunity to earn both high school credit from the District and college credit through Eastern Washington University.

Pullman High School teacher Bryce Gravel updated the Curriculum Advisory Council of the need to update the calculus text to that used by Eastern Washington; *Calculus: Early Transcendentals*, 9th edition by J. Stewart, D. Clegg, and S. Watson. In addition to its use as the EWU text, he communicated to the CAC he is familiar with the text when he taught calculus in his previous school, and believes it will be a positive update for instruction. Joni Stevens, Pullman School District TOSA, confirmed this is a good college text and will be good for Pullman High students.

Pullman High School Principal Juston Pollestad agreed that it is time to provide an updated text and this update is curriculum used by Eastern Washington University in this dual credit course. He also added that there is donation money available to make the purchase of the books for use beginning in the 2024-25 school year.

The CAC members thanked Bryce for the update.
