The surrounding area offers access to educational outdoor endeavors including water and mountain activities.

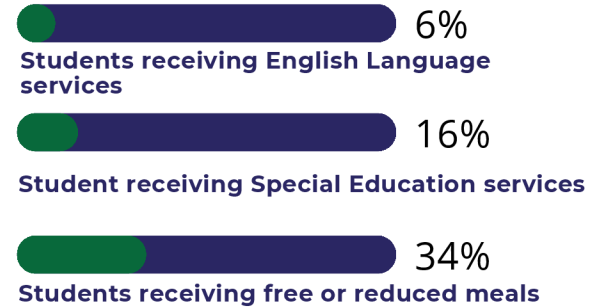


### CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

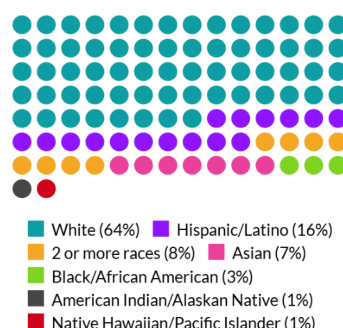

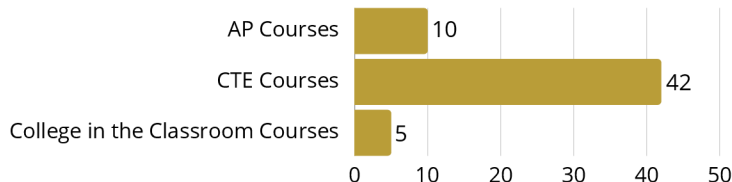
